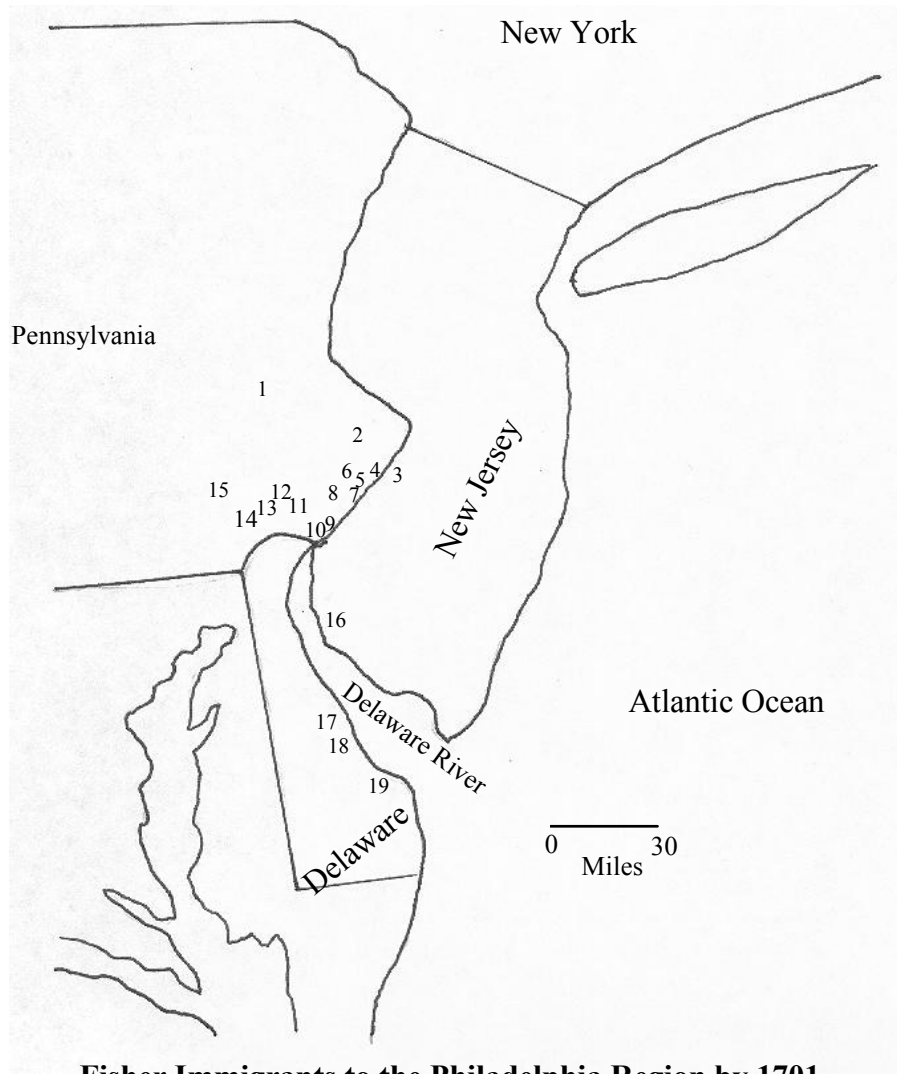


The First Fishers of Pennsylvania and Adjacent Colonies



Fisher Immigrants to the Philadelphia Region by 1701

1. Buckingham Township – John Fisher from Cumberland, 1700; died here in 1765.
2. Falls Township – John Fisher arrived from Pardshaw, Cumberland, 1700.
3. Burlington – William Fisher & cousin John Fisher, by 1696.
4. Philadelphia & County – Joseph Fisher from Stillorgan Parish, Dublin County, Ireland, 1683.
5. Philadelphia – William Fisher from Ross in Herefordshire, 1684.
6. Philadelphia – John and Katharine Fisher lived in Springfield Township, Philadelphia County. He died in 1726.
7. Kingsessing, Mouth of Schuylkill River – John & Sarah Fisher, by 1684.
8. Marple Township – Francis & Grace Standfield from Cheshire, 1683.
9. Chester – George Fisher, town lot in 1688.
10. Chichester – John Fisher died here 1701, wife Barbara.
11. Concord Township – Thomas Fisher & Elizabeth Huntley married at Concord Monthly Meeting, 1713.
12. Thornbury Township – William Fisher was agent for Elizabeth Andross land purchase here, 1696.
13. Birmingham Township – William Huntley here by 1691.
14. Kennett Township – Thomas Fisher & Thomas Robinson land, 1701.
15. East Caln Township, Thomas Fisher died here, 1747 (In part now West Brandywine Township)
16. Salem & Allowayes, “Monmouth River” – Dennis & Susannah Fisher came from Portsmouth, Hampshire & Chichester, Sussex, here by 1683.
17. Kent County – Adam Fisher here by 1693.
18. Cedar Creek, Sussex County – William Fisher, wife Rebecca, here by 1693.
19. Lewes, Sussex County – John & Margaret Fisher from Marsden & Clitheroe, Lancashire 1682/3 to Philadelphia & Delaware.
